

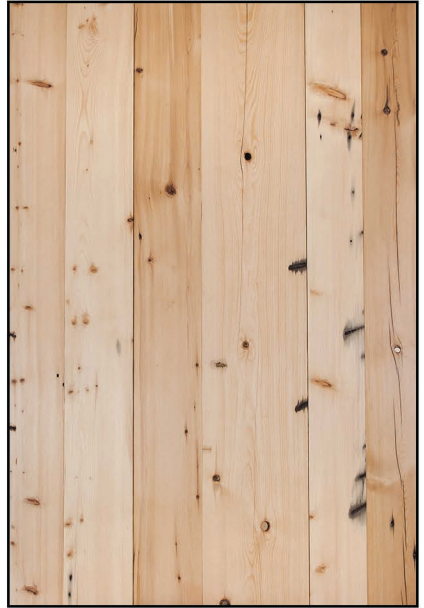
# Reclaimed White Wood



This floor is a mix of reclaimed Eastern White Pine, hemlock, fir, Tamarack, and spruce salvaged from barns and mill buildings.

Light color, occasional nail holes, light checking, and scattered knots make this a bright, rustic floor reminiscent of industrial loft spaces and casual farm houses.

Reclaimed White Wood flooring is milled square-edged for traditional face-nail installation.



## Standard Dimensions

4" - 10" widths, random width only  
4' to 12' lengths  
3/4" thick, square-edged

## Grain

Straight, with typical old-growth softwood irregularities. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

## Color

Bright white to golden/creamy, with variations into light brown and chestnut colors. Occasional reddish hues.

## Character

Large and small knots, nail holes, checking, and black mineral staining define the floor. Range of tones and coloration amongst species.

## Hardness & Stability

A soft and stable flooring. Average of approximately 487lb<sub>f</sub> on the Janka hardness scale. ~1.81 pounds per square foot.



## Certifications

Qualifies for LEED MRc3, Materials Reuse credit. May qualify for LEED MRc5, Regional Materials credit.
